

CO-ED T-BALL RULES

1. **HAVE FUN**
2. Everybody plays.
3. All players can take the field every inning no matter the size of the team. Teams must follow the regulation infield of one pitcher, first basemen, second baseman, third baseman, and shortstop. The remaining players can be in the outfield behind the bases.
4. A regulation game shall be 4 innings or 45-minute time limit. If there are five (5) minutes or less remaining in the 45-minute, no new inning shall begin.
5. An inning will stop after every batter gets to bat once.
6. NO STEALING. No steel spikes.
7. Field measurements: Bases – 60’
8. Batters that become base runners should run through the double first base on the orange side.
9. Each runner only gets to advance one (1) base; except the last batter, they get to run all bases.
10. If a runner gets out, they shall be declared out but will be allowed to stay on base.
11. The ERC staff will decide on rainouts and rescheduling.
12. Coaches are responsible for all equipment, coach manuals, and videos to be returned to the director at the end of the season.
13. Coaches are responsible for players in regard to practice. Do not leave them on their own, it is poor policy.
14. Each batter will have as many chances as they need to contact and hit the ball off of the tee.
15. Coaches: please do not play soft toss into our fences, if you want to play soft toss, please do so at the batting cages into the nets. Also please remember to tell your players to stay off of the fences (climbing, hanging, etc.)
16. STRESS SPORTSMANSHIP ABOVE ALL!!!
